


How to Print Test Reports & Graph Test Results:


- 1) Open AccuTEST
- 2) Select the profile for the valve that you would like a report for.



Confirm that the profile you want a previous test from is selected.

3) Go to "Report (F9)" tab, select a single, or a many tests from a list of completed tests (should say "AS FOUND" followed by the date of the test)






Tip: Ctrl+Click selects single files, selecting open with many files will allow the user to print a report with an attribute of "Compute Average" as well as select the units you'd like to use with the test.



Tip: A technician can include Test Comments for context in the box in this window.

4) Selecting OK generates a "Safety Valve Test Report". To include your company's image and information, close the test report, and navigate to the "Setup" tab in the top-left of the window.






Select "Company Information" to fill in the company information, select "Report Image" to select an image you'd like to see on the report.




Fill in your company information to the best of your abilities, this will show up on the test report.



Selecting "Report Image", you need to select the image by navigating your file directory for an image that can be used.



5) To print a graph along with the report, close out of any open window in AccuTEST, locate the file icon in the top left corner.




6) Select the test you would like to have a graph for and select open. The graph for that test will now appear on the screen.




7) Go to File, Print





- 8) Select the printer that you would like to use
 - a. To print to PDF



- 9) Graph will print or be displayed as a PDF
 - a. At the top you will find the profile information along with test results and set point.
